'A Gift for Living' Proposal

A sponsorship programme to support children in an Orphanage in Jinja, Uganda, providing each child with food, shelter, medication, clothes, and education.

To protect the safety and wellbeing of children in the care of the orphanage. Through your charity, Lions Clubs International – 'A Gift for Living' we would receive donations and administer the sponsorship programme. Whilst it would be a new route for A Gift for Living, the Trustees have the necessary skills, experience, and knowledge to successfully deliver.

Background

Many may remember, the Malawi children's education sponsorship programme from some years ago. It was well organised but unfortunately supported only by a few local administrators and sadly there was insufficient succession planning. Having recently concluded a visit to witness at first hand, PID Phil Nathan has seen and been emotionally touched by the needs of the children in an Orphanage in Jinja, Uganda. There is currently a Trust operating, (Shield of Faith Community Empowerment Organisation), in the area that was set up by a totally dedicated young Lion who was himself an orphan and adopted. There are currently 40 children aged 4-16 years who are cared for by the Trust and volunteers. These young adults are educated and taught a trade, until age 16.

The critical need

The current Trust is struggling financially and has a number of requirements to continue to operate. There are also complexities of Ugandan rules and regulations. If it closes, the children are likely to end up on the street. The consequences of this would likely lead to trafficking and probable prostitution. It is our hope that through A Gift for Living we can step in to support these children and to encourage the global Lions community to sponsor these children.

Costs

The cost per child per year is \$480 (approx. £390) and over the ten-year sponsorship programme the cost is \$4,800 (approx £3,900).

No allowance for inflation or exchange rate fluctuations during the proposed ten-year period are included in the above figures.

This will provide each child with food, shelter, medication, clothes, and education.

Flights are still relatively cheap, direct from Heathrow to Hanover multiple times per day, and with this hosting offer, a weekend meeting and getting to know Lions from not only our Twin District 111NH, but all over Germany and beyond, is very affordable.

The official program for the weekend includes: -

Friday 10th May: Welcome to Hanover, Workshops and seminars (approx a dozen), Panel Discussion, Music Competition, Young Ambassador Competition, with a "Get Together" in the evening. NB some of these are on at the same time, but you can choose which, if any, you want to attend.

Saturday 11th May: Ceremony, Multiple District Convention plenary session, Gala Evening and then Leos disco from 11pm (if you can stand the pace)

Sunday 12th May: Religious Service, Farewell

In addition, there are all sorts of other events for visitors, including various walks through the city, sightseeing in a vintage bus, visit to the Herrenhäuser baroque gardens that won the European Garden Prize in 2015, various Art Museums (Sprengel Museum "Pablo Picasso/Max Beckmann" and "Wilhelm Busch Museum"), open air Jazz, a visit to the Zoo and a tour of a wine (Sekt – like champagne, but German) cellar, with tasting. And there are lots of bars for you to relax in and mix with Lions from all over Germany and the rest of the world.

There may also be opportunities to provide service during your visit or stay for a few days before or after the weekend, probably in a hotel, but up to you and your hosts to decide.

There is even a 2-day travel pass on all public transport for only €8.

And if all the hosting places are gone, hotel rooms start at €70 per night. That's where I have booked, so I'll see you there.

And don't forget your Duty Free on the way home!

In addition, there is the Netherlands Convention from the 1st to the 2nd of June.

So, there you have plenty of chances to join in our twinning events in the not-toodistant future.


