Past Director Anderson is a Doctor of Optometry in private practice for 45 years.

A member of the Grand Rapids Lions Club since 1979, he has held many offices within the association, including club president, district governor and council chairperson. He also served as CSFII district coordinator, host committee chairman of the 2007 USA/Canada Forum in Grand Rapids, a member of the USA/Canada Forum planning committee 8 years, culminating in being the General Chairperson for the




2016 USA/Canada Lions Leadership Forum in Omaha. Past Director Anderson was a DGE Group leader at the International Conventions in Hamburg and Montreal and has led or participated in 42 Lions vision missions to Mexico, the Caribbean, Central and South America, Kenya, and Suriname. PID Anderson is also a board member of Lions KidSight USA and served as a Board Appointee 2021-2022 for LCI President Douglas X. Alexander.

In recognition of his service to the association, he has received numerous awards including the Henry Voet Grand Rapids Lifetime Achievement Award, the Lions of Michigan Foundation Humanitarian Award, the Grandville and Betty Cutler Leadership Award, the S.A. Dodge MD-11 Distinguished Service Award, the Lions of Michigan Hall of Fame, one International President's Leadership Award, ten International President's Medals and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honour the association bestows upon its members. He is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow and a Major Donor for Campaign 100.



In addition to his Lions activities, Past Director Anderson is active in numerous professional and community organizations, including the American Optometric Association and the Michigan Optometric Association. He has also served as a member of the Michigan Eye Bank board and as Board President of the Association for the Blind and Visually Impaired.

Past Director Anderson and his wife, Cheryl, also a Lion and a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow, have one son and two daughters, all of whom are Lions and whose spouses are Lions. They have three grandsons and four granddaughters who are all future Lions.

PEACE POSTER COMPETITION.

Each year Lions clubs across the world proudly sponsor the Lions club international peace poster art contest in local schools and youth groups.

This Years theme is Peace Without Limits. Kits cost £14 each which consists of rules, sticker, and certificate. Kits can be ordered by contacting peace poster officer Mel Godefroy, please order by middle of February so posters can be delivered to convention for collection. Invoices will be sent to clubs after this date posters can be ordered from Birmingham HQ until 1st oct, but this will incur extra cost for postage and packaging. Winning posters must be returned to Mel in good time preferably by Monday 11th November or if you attend new century charter the 15th, November so they can be judged on the 16th, November 2024.

Artwork must be no smaller than 13x20 inches(33cmx50cm), and no bigger than 20x24 inches (50x60 cm). A2 paper is ideal, no frames or any framework permitted. The contest is open for 11 to 13 years of age only. Nothing may be glued, stapled, or attached to artwork. The use of lettering or numbering on the front of the poster, in any language, is not allowed.

Finally, each poster is judged on originality, artistic merit, and expression of the theme. We also have a special needs category. Order your packs now.
