Lions are Providing Lifesaving Aid to Hurricane Victims

Dear Lions and Friends,

Hurricane Otis made landfall in Acapulco and surrounding areas of Mexico as a Category 5 hurricane reaching wind speeds of 165 mph, the strongest storm on record to hit the area. The full scale of the devastation is still unclear, with communication systems down, but it is estimated that dozens of people have been killed with several still missing. Homes and other buildings in the path of the storm have been destroyed.

Lions in the region are already poised to help and Lions Clubs International Foundation is mobilising funds, including a US\$50,000 Major Catastrophe Grant and a US\$10,000 Emergency Grant, to empower them as they help their communities recover.
