

THE LONG-AWAITED LIONS PORTAL

I am pleased to be able to inform you that the new Lions Portal will begin to go live on 15 April 2024. Registered users will receive an email, on a rolling basis, informing them when and how to access the new system.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NOW

It is important that all club secretaries ensure that member entries on MyLCI are up to date. It is particularly important to ensure that dates of birth and email addresses are correct. It should be noted that users will need a unique and unshared email and that phone numbers will no longer be supported as a log in credential.

THE PROCESS

From 12 April MyLion and MyLCI will no longer be accessible.

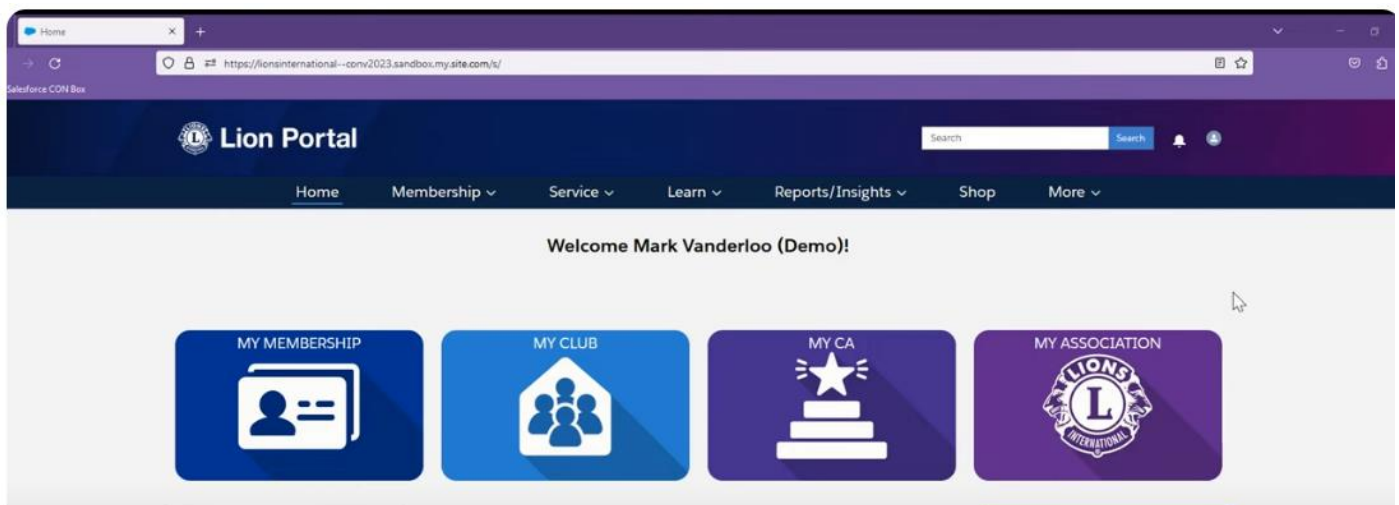
Between 15 April and 13 May registered users will receive an email from LCI inviting them to register on the new system – instructions of how to do this will be included in the email.

After 13 May anyone trying to access the old system will be automatically redirected to the new portal.

WHAT YOU CAN DO TO PREPARE
