On Wednesday I attended the funeral of a spouse of a lion who died suddenly. A very good service that was well attended.

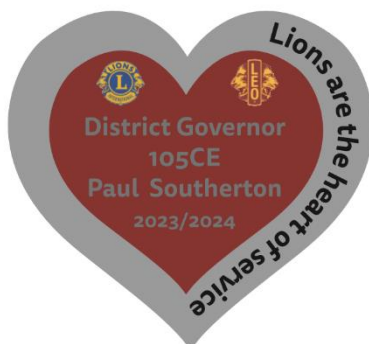
