



The Bert Mason Lions Humanitarian Award



Recommendation for an Award

The recommendation can come from the following Lions groups in Multiple District 105:

- a)** Lions, Lionesses, Leo Clubs **b)** Zone
c) Region **d)** District 105 **e)** Multiple District 105

The recommendation must be presented in a full and written citation.

Criteria for the Award

The award is for Lions, Lionesses and Leos, who have served Lionism for at least a year and a day before they can be recommended for the award. Any Lion, Lioness and Leo recommended for the award must have given exceptional service for humanitarian needs.

Adjudication of Recommendations

In the case of **a)**, **b)**, **c)** and **d)**, the recommendation with citation is to be evaluated and decided upon by the relevant District Governor and /or his Cabinet. In the case of **e)**, the recommendation with the citation is to be evaluated and decided upon by the Chairman of Council and the Council of Governors.

Composition of the Award

The award will be a medal and certificate. The medal ribbon is to be a combination of the colours purple and gold. The medal will show the bell used a Bert Mason's presidential logo. The medal is to be engraved with the name of the recipient and the words "*Bert Mason Lions Humanitarian Award*". The certificate to incorporate the Lions logo and the bell.

Cost of the Award

The cost will be **£375** including postage and packing. **£125** will be used for administration and **£250** used for humanitarian work, shared equally between a Multiple District 105 Youth Project and Lions Club International Foundation.

Financial Administration

The finances to be administered by a Committee composed of Chairman of Council, the MD Treasurer, and the MD Charities Treasurer. This is not to be considered as either a Trust or a Fellowship. Disbursement of the accumulated funds for the MD 105 Youth Project will be decided by the Council of Governors on the recommendation of the Committee.

Presentation

The presentation of the award is to be made, with the citation read in full, on a special occasion, by a Lion according to the protocol.

A Progressive Award

A progressive award of one or more diamonds can be awarded to a recipient for the same cost of **£375**. This can be self-funded and enables an award holder to support the intended endeavours if so desired.

Records

All awards will be recorded in an Honour Book, to be displayed in a prominent position at MD HQ and also shown on the MD website.
